- Setting and operating multi-axis CNC mill / turn machine tools to achieve maximum efficiency and the highest quality standards for the manufacture of precision engineered metallic components.
- Competent use of Siemens NX CAM software to support our dedicated CAM Programmers for CNC code optimisation and troubleshooting to deliver improvements as required.



- Maximising throughput and overall machine tool efficiency.
- Operating and maintaining all other equipment in the team's small bespoke machine shop
- Managing stocks and supplies as needed
- Manage movement and set up of machines and checking calibrations (training can be provided)
- Ensuring that safety equipment is up to date and in good working order
- Working on various other projects as part of the shore operations team
- Assist with race yacht preparation where necessary
- Assist with logistical operations like setting up bases, loading and unloading shipping containers
